Reestablishment of the Survey Executed by
C.C. Tracy, U.S. Deputy Surveyor,
in 1869.

From the cor. of Tps. 37 and 38 N., Rs. 59 and 60 E.
N. 88° 21' W., bet. secs. 1 and 36.

Over gently rolling land, through sagebrush.

- 5.00 Enter nearly level meadow land.
- 25.50 Marys River, 30 lks. wide, 3 ft. deep, course S.
- 40.39 Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 36, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 6 ins. below the surface of the ground, with brass cap mkd.

- 53.00 Slough, course S.
- 59.60 Fence, bears NNW. and SSE.; leave meadow land and enter level land.
- 80.78 Point for the cor. of secs. 1, 2, 35 and 36, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
