Reestablishment of the Survey Executed by  
C.C. Tracy, U.S. Deputy Surveyor,  
in 1869.

The cor. of secs. 25, 26, 35 and 36, determined latitudinally in line with fence to the E. and longitudinally in line with fence to the S. This point is recognized as the cor. by adjacent landowners and is accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 6 ins. below the surface of the ground, with brass cap mkd.

Over nearly level land, through sagebrush and willows.

16.30 Graded gravel road, bears SSW. and NNE.

20.70 Graded gravel road, bears NNW. and SSE.

23.00 Marys River, 40 lks. wide, 2 ft. deep, course W.

33.90 Western Pacific Railroad tracks, bear N. 61° E. and S. 61° W.

40.55 The ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 25 and 26, determined by calculated tie from the Plan of the Town of Deeth, as surveyed by C.M. Haws, in 1910 and on file in the courthouse at Elko, Nevada.

At the corner point

Set a copper-coated steel stake, 18 ins. long, ½ in. diam., 4 ins. below the surface of a graded gravel road, bearing N. 7½° E. and S. 4½° W., with top mkd.
