DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF THE EIGHTH STANDARD PARALLEL NORTH,  
THROUGH A PORTION OF RANGE 54 EAST,  
MOUNT DIABLO MERIDIAN, NEVADA

Reestablishment of the Survey Executed by  
U.S. Deputy Surveyors, A.J. Hatch and J.H. Eaton,  
in 1870,  
and Resurveyed by U.S. Deputy Surveyor, H.B. Maxson,  
in 1900.

The standard corner of secs. 32 and 33, monumented with  
an iron post, 2½ ins. diam., firmly set and exposed  
10 ins. above ground, with a mound of stone, 3 ft. base,  
2 ft. high, N. of cor., with brass cap mkd. as described  
in the field notes of the dependent resurvey of the  
Eighth Standard Parallel North, through a portion of  
R. 54 E., surveyed under Group No. 404, in 1963.

From this corner, the closing corner of secs. 4 and 5,  
T. 40 N., R. 54 E., monumented with an iron post, 2½ ins.  
diam., firmly set and exposed 8 ins. above ground, with a  
mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, S. of cor., with  
brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the  
dependent resurvey of the Eighth Standard Parallel North,  
through a portion of R. 54 E., surveyed under Group No.  
404 in 1963, bears S. 89° 56' E., 2.78 chs. dist.

N. 89° 44' W., along the S. bdy. of sec. 32.

Over mountainous land, through sagebrush and scattered  
aspens; asc. 200 ft. over a S. slope.

37.185 Point for the N. ¼ sec. cor. of sec. 5, at midpoint and  
on the S. bdy. of sec. 32.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 12 ins.  
in the ground to bedrock and in a mound of stone, 3½ ft.  
base to top, with brass cap mkd.

40.00 The standard ¼ sec. cor. of sec. 32, monumented with a  
basalt stone, 14x7x7 ins., plainly mkd. with SC ¼ on  
the N. face, firmly set in a mound of stone.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 15 ins.  
in the ground to bedrock and in a mound of stone, 3½ ft.  
base to top, with brass cap mkd.
