Reestablishment of the Survey Executed by
C.S. Preble and James Thorburn, U.S. Deputy Surveyors,
in 1881.

From the cor. of Tps. 29 and 30 N., R. 67 E., monumented with an aluminum post, 2½ ins. diam., firmly set and exposed 4 ins. above the ground, with aluminum cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the dependent resurvey of the east boundary of T. 29 N., R. 67 E., executed under Group No. 539.

N. 0° 13' E., along the E. bdy. of sec. 36.

Over nearly level land, through scattered undergrowth.

22.09 The ¼ sec. cor. of sec. 31, T. 30 N., R. 68 E., hereinafter described.

40.08 Point for the ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 31 and 36, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner. This corner now refers to the ¼ sec. cor. of sec. 36 only.

Set an aluminum post, 30 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with aluminum cap mkd.
