INDEPENDENT RESURVEY OF THE SUBDIVISIONAL LINES,
T. 30 N., R. 68 E., MOUNT DIABLO MERIDIAN, NEVADA

This Independent Resurvey Supersedes the Survey Executed by C.S. Preble and James Thorburn, U.S. Deputy Surveyors, in 1881. A diligent search was made for the original corners and none were found.

From the cor. of secs. 1, 2, 35 and 36, on the S. bdy. of the Tp., monumented with an aluminum post, 2½ ins. diam., firmly set in a mound of stone, with aluminum cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the independent resurvey of the N. bdy. of T. 29 N., R. 68 E., executed under this same Group.

N. 0° 01' W., bet. secs. 35 and 36.

Over mountainous land, through medium timber and scattered undergrowth; desc. 100 ft. along E. slope changing to a NE. slope.

5.80 Draw, drains E.; asc. 200 ft. over SSE. slope.

21.70 Spur, slopes E.; desc. 510 ft. over NNE. slope.

40.00 Point for the ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 35 and 36.

Set an aluminum post, 30 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., on solid rock over a cross (X) and in a mound of stone, 4 ft. base to top, with aluminum cap mkd.

A pinon, 17 ins. diam., bears S. 60° W., 22 lks. dist., mkd. ¼ S 35 BT.

Ascend 300 ft. over SE. slope.

69.60 Spur, slopes E.; desc. 180 ft. over NE. slope.

80.00 Point for the cor. of secs. 25, 26, 35 and 36.

Set an aluminum post, 30 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 4 ins. in the ground to bedrock and in a mound of stone, 4 ft. base to top, with aluminum cap mkd.
