GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The land surveyed within Township 41 North, Range 53 East is located on the western slope of the Independence Mountains. The soil consists of a sandy clay loam and rocky in the higher elevations. The vegetation consists of sagebrush and native grasses.

The land surveyed is drained by several creeks which all flow in a general westerly direction. A house is located in sec. 31.

Principal use of the land is for grazing livestock. Access into the township is provided by improved and unimproved roads. No mineral formations of consequence were noted during the survey.
