The elevation varies from 5,300 to 5,600 ft. above sea level. The soil consists mainly of sandy loam.</p> <p data-bbox="391 567 1259 696">Access to the area is provided by Nevada State Highway No. 20, which crosses the area from south to north. Further access is provided by numerous gravel, dirt, and jeep roads.</p> <p data-bbox="391 731 1318 889">Drainage to the area is provided by Duckwater Creek, which drains in generally a southerly direction. Numerous irrigation ditches from Duckwater Creek, provide water for cultivation purposes. The principle uses of the land are for growing hay and grazing cattle.</p> <p data-bbox="391 924 1031 954">No mineral deposits of value were noted.</p> <p data-bbox="391 989 1309 1051">The mean magnetic declination is 16½° E., with a range of 1° due to local attraction.</p>	
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
