This cor. now refers to secs. 18 and 19 only. Monroe</p> <hr/> <p>From the cor. of secs. 4, 5, 32 and 33, Tps. 12 and 13 N., R. 56 E., monumented with a lime rock, 14 x 8 x 6 ins., with 6 grooves and an X chiseled on E. face, firmly set, in a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 1½ ft. high, alongside of which is set a 6 ft. steel fence post.</p> <p>At the cor. point</p> <p>Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 2 ins. in the ground, on solid bedrock, with X chiseled at cor. point, in a mound of stone, 3½ ft. base, to top, with brass cap mkd.</p> <div><div>T 13 N R 56 E</div><div><div>S 32 S 33</div><div>S 5 S 4</div></div><div>T 12 N</div></div> <p>1976</p> <p>Deposit the original stone alongside the iron post.</p> <p>Reset the 6 ft. steel fence post alongside the iron post.</p> <p>S. 89° 50' W., along the S. bdy. of the tp., bet. secs. 5 and 32.</p> <p>Desc. over steep and rocky bluff.</p>
0.80	Base of bluff, bears N. and S.; continue over nearly level land, through moderate sagebrush and native grasses.
19.91	<p>Point for the E. 1/16 sec. cor. of secs. 5 and 32.</p> <p>Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.</p>
