## GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The area surveyed is about 4 miles north of Duck-water, Nevada. Access is by Nevada State Highway No. 20, with numerous jeep trails throughout the area.

The elevation ranges from about 5500 to 5800 ft. above sea level. The soil is mainly sandy loam. There is extensive rock outcropping in the easterly portion of the area. The only vegetation is scattered sagebrush. Drainage is southwesterly to Duckwater Creek.

No mineralization was noted along the lines surveyed. There is no habitation in the area, and principal use of the area is livestock grazing.

The mean magnetic declination is  $16\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  E., with a range of 1° due to local attraction.
