The elevation varies from about 5,900 to 8,000 feet above sea level. The soil varies from sandy clay loam and rocky in the higher elevation to black loam on the bottom land. The vegetation consists of juniper, sagebrush and native grasses.</p> <p>The Southern Pacific Railroad crosses the Township NW. to SE. entering the Township in sec. 25 and leaving in sec. 6.</p> <p>Principal users of the area are cattlemen and access into the Township is provided by numerous secondary and desert trail roads.
