9.030 Point for Cor. No. 2 of M.S. 2065 Viola lode, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner. POINT NOT MONUMENTED.

Thence SOUTH.

1.776 Intersect the line bet. secs. 19 and 30 at a point from which cor. of secs. 19, 20, 29 and 30 bears S.  $89^{\circ} 14'$  E., 7.930 chs. dist., hereinbefore described.
