

SURVEY OF A PORTION OF THE SUBDIVISIONAL LINES,
T. 5 S., R. 66 E., MDM, NEVADA

CHAINS

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The land surveyed within Township 5 South, Range 66 East, is mountainous. The elevation ranges from about 3900 to 5700 ft. above sea level. The soil varies from sandy clay to rocky. The vegetation consists of sagebrush and rabbitbrush. There is scattered to medium juniper and pinon over most of the area.

There is a spring in section 27. Access into the township is provided by an improved road to Elgin.

The township is drained by the Meadow Valley Wash, which drains southerly through the township.

Principal users of the area are cattlemen.

No mineral formations of consequence were noted during the survey.
