NORTH, along the E. bdy. of sec. 33.

Over rolling land, through scattered undergrowth.

The cor. of Tps. 2 and 3 S., R. 52 E., monumented with  
an iron post, 2½ ins. diam., exposed 4 ins. above the  
ground, steel fence post set alongside, with brass cap  
mkd. as described in the field notes of the survey of  
the N. bdy. of T. 3 S., R. 52 E., executed concurrently  
under this same group.

Land, rolling.

Soil, sandy clay.

Undergrowth, greasewood.

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The lines surveyed in Township 2 South, Range 51½ East,  
is over rolling land. The elevation ranges from about  
5800 to 6100 ft. above sea level. The soil varies from  
sandy clay to rocky. The vegetation consists of  
scattered rabbitbrush and greasewood.

Access into the Township is provided by numerous improved  
and unimproved trail roads.

Principal users of the area are cattlemen.

No mineral formations of consequence were noted during  
the progress of the survey.
