GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The south boundary of Township 7 South, Range 56 East,
varies from mountainous to gently rolling. The elevation
ranges from about 4700 to 5200 ft. above sea level. The
soil varies from sandy clay to rocky. The vegetation
consists of greasewood and Joshua trees.

Access into the township is provided by improved and
unimproved desert and trail roads.

No mineral formations of consequence were noted during
the survey.
