	CHAINS	<p data-bbox="705 330 1011 357">GENERAL DESCRIPTION</p> <p data-bbox="401 395 1301 653">The area resurveyed on the Second Standard Parallel South through Range 60 East and a portion of 61 East is gently rolling to rolling. The elevation ranges from about 4360 to 4790 ft. above sea level. The soil varies from sandy clay loam in the lower elevations to sandy clay loam and rocky in the higher elevations. The vegetation consists of greasewood, shadscale, Joshua trees and scattered bunch grass.</p> <p data-bbox="401 688 1267 749">Principal users of the area are cattlemen and access into the Township is provided by numerous trail roads.</p> <p data-bbox="401 784 1272 846">No mineral formations of consequence were noted during the survey.</p>
