8	The area resurveyed on the Second Standard Parallel South through Range 60 East and a portion of 61 East is gently rolling to rolling. The elevation ranges from about 4360 to 4790 ft. above sea level. The soil varies from sandy clay loam in the lower elevations to sandy clay loam and rocky in the higher elevations. The vegetation consists of greasewood, shadscale, Joshua trees and scattered bunch grass.
	Principal users of the area are cattlemen and access into the Township is provided by numerous trail roads. No mineral formations of consequence were noted during the survey.
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
