From the original cor. of secs. 7, 12, 13 and 18, monumented with a granite stone, 20x6x6 ins., firmly set in a mound of stone, and exposed 15 ins. above the ground, plainly mkd. with 4 notches on S. edge and 2 notches on N. edge. This corner now refers to the cor. of secs. 7 and 18 only.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

At the corner point
