Haman, U.S. Forest Ranger in 1916.</div> <div>From the original cor. of secs. 7, 12, 13 and 18, monu- mented with a granite stone, 20x6x6 ins., firmly set in a mound of stone, and exposed 15 ins. above the ground, plainly mkd. with 4 notches on S. edge and 2 notches on N. edge.
