DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF A PORTION OF THE NORTH BOUNDARY,  
T. 8 N., R. 39 E., MOUNT DIABLO MERIDIAN, NEVADA

Reestablishment of the Survey Executed by  
Glover and Perrin, U.S. Deputy Surveyors,  
in 1880.

The original cor. of secs. 2, 3, 3<sup>4</sup> and 35, monumented with a granite stone, 14x10x8 ins., firmly set and exposed 8 ins. above the ground, in a mound of stone, plainly mkd., with 2 notches on the N. edge and 4 notches on the W. edge. This corner now refers to the cor. of secs. 2 and 3, only.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> ins. diam., on solid rock, over a cross (X) and in a mound of stone to cap, 4 ft. base, with brass cap mkd.

N. 89° 42' W., along the N. bdy. of sec. 3.

Over mountainous land, through scattered sagebrush; asc. 250 ft. over E. slope to ridge.

0.67 The closing cor. of secs. 3<sup>4</sup> and 35, T. 9 N., R. 39 E., monumented with an iron post, 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> ins. diam., set on solid rock, over a cross (X) and in a mound of stone to cap, 5 ft. base, with brass cap mkd., as described in the field notes of the survey of a portion of the subdivisional lines of T. 9 N., R. 39 E., executed concurrently under this same group.

30.60 Ridge, bears N. and S.; desc. 170 ft. over broken rocky W. slope.

39.10 The original <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> sec. cor. of secs. 3 and 3<sup>4</sup>, monumented with a granite stone, 16x12x6 ins., firmly set and exposed 10 ins. above the ground, in a mound of stone, plainly mkd. <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> on N. face. This corner now refers to the <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> sec. cor. of sec. 3, only.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> ins. diam., 8 ins. in the ground to bedrock and in a mound of stone to cap, 4 ft. base, with brass cap mkd.
