The elevation ranges from about 5600 to 6000 ft. above sea level. The soil varies from sandy clay loam to rocky. The vegetation consists of scattered sagebrush greasewood, shadscale and native grasses.</p> <p>Access into the township is provided by numerous secondary and desert trail roads.</p> <p>Principal users of the area are cattlemen.</p> <p>No mineral formations of consequence were noted during the resurvey.</p>
