Point for the closing cor. of secs. 34 and 35, T. 9 N., R. 39 E.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., on solid rock over a cross (X) and in a mound of stone to cap, 5 ft. base, with brass cap mkd.

The cor. of secs. 2 and 3, T. 8 N., R. 39 E., monumented with an iron post, 2½ ins. diam., set on solid rock and in a mound of stone to cap, 4 ft. base, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the dependent resurvey of a portion of the N. bdy. of T. 8 N., R. 39 E., executed concurrently under this same group, bears S. 89° 42' E., 0.67 chs. dist.

Land, mountainous.
Soil, sandy clay and rocky.
Timber, juniper and pinon.

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The land surveyed within Township 9 North, Range 39 East, is rolling to mountainous. The elevation ranges from about 5600 to 7000 ft. above sea level. The soil varies from sandy clay to rocky. The vegetation consists of scattered sagebrush and greasewood. There is scattered juniper and pinon on the higher elevations.

Access into the township is provided by numerous secondary and desert trail roads.

Principal users of the area are cattlemen.

No mineral formations of consequence were noted during the survey.
