

DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF
A PORTION OF THE SUBDIVISIONAL LINES,
T. 35 N., R. 66 E., MDM, NEVADA

CHAINS

Point for the N. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 5, at midpoint bet. the closing corners and on the S. bdy. of sec. 31, T. 36 N., R. 66 E.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

set a steel fence post, $5\frac{1}{2}$ ft. long, 2 ft. in the ground, alongside the iron post.

From this corner, the standard cor. of secs. 31 and 32, T. 36 N., R. 66 E., monumented with an iron post, 2 ins. diam., firmly set showing 10 ins. above the ground, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the dependent resurvey of T. 36 N., R. 66 E., executed under Group No. 26, bears N. $89^{\circ} 55' W.$, 6.925 chs. dist.

Point for the N. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 6, at proportionate distance and on the S. bdy. of sec. 31, T. 36 N., R. 66 E.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

From this corner the Standard cor. of Tps. 36 N., Rs. 65 and 66 E., hereinbefore described, bears S. $89^{\circ} 38' W.$, 7.93 chs. dist.

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The land within Township 35 North, Range 66 East, ranges from about 5,500 to 8,000 ft. above sea level, the soil in the eastern portion of the township is a sandy clay loam and the western portion being of a gravel nature to rocky.

There are numerous trail roads throughout the township, there is a well located in section 28, and an abandon house in section 22.

Principal users of the area are cattlemen and ranchers; there were no mineral formations noted in the area.
