Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground and in a collar of stone, 3 ft. base to top, with brass cap mkd.

DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF A PORTION OF THE SOUTH BOUNDARY,

Reestablishment of the Survey Executed by
U.S. Deputy Surveyors E.B. Monroe and E.C. McClellan
in 1881.

From the cor. of secs. 3, 4, 33 and 34, on the S. bdy. of the Tp., monumented with a basalt stone, 16x9x8 ins., firmly set in a mound of stone, mkd. with 3 grooves on the E. and W. faces.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

bury the original cornerstone and set a steel fence post, 6 ft. long, 22 ins. in the ground, alongside the iron post and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1½ ft. high, W. of cor.

Over rolling land, covered with sagebrush, bunchgrass and crested wheatgrass.

12.50 Trail road, bears N. and S.

40.53 Point for the ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 4 and 33, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.
