

DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF A PORTION OF THE  
SUBDIVISIONAL LINES OF  
T. 38 N., R. 57 E., MDM, NEVADA

CHAINS

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The area resurveyed within Township 38 North, Range 57 East is rolling to gently rolling. The soil varies from sandy clay loam and rocky on the higher elevations. The vegetation consists of sagebrush, native grasses and scattered willows along the North Fork of the Humboldt River. The elevation ranges from about 5300 ft. to 6000 ft. above sea level.

The township is drained by the North Fork of the Humboldt River which flows south through the east tier of sections.

The Devils Gate Ranch is located in sections 35 and 36.

Principal users of the area are cattlemen and access into the township is provided by improved and unimproved roads. No mineral formations of consequence were noted during the survey.
