Reestablishment of the Survey Executed by  
U.S. Deputy Surveyors  
A.J. Hatch, D.H. Barker and E.L. Bridges,  
in 1873.

From the cor. of secs. 1, 2, 35 and 36, on the S. bdy.  
of the Tp., monumented with an iron post,  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam.,  
exposed 4 ins. above ground, with brass cap mkd. as  
described in the field notes of the dependent resurvey  
of T. 11 N., R. 43 E., executed under Group No. 450.

N.  $2^{\circ} 18'$  W., bet. secs. 35 and 36.

Over gently rolling land, through scattered greasewood.

45.11 Point for the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of secs. 35 and 36, at  
proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence  
of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long,  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam., 24 ins.  
in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

illegible scribe marks visible.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long,  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam., 24 ins.  
in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
