	<hr/> <p style="text-align: center;">GENERAL DESCRIPTION</p> <p>The land resurveyed within Township 12 North, Range 44 East, varies from rolling to nearly level land. The elevation ranges from about 5600 to 6400 ft. above sea level. The soil varies from sandy clay to gravel and rocky. The vegetation consists of greasewood and native grasses. There is no timber in the township. Moores Creek flows WNW. through the central portion of the township.</p> <p>Principal users of the area are cattlemen and access into the township is provided by improved and unimproved roads.</p> <p>No mineral formations of consequence were noted during the resurvey.</p> <hr/>
