GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The area surveyed and resurveyed within Township 13 North, Range 44 East, varies from mountainous in the east portion to nearly level in the west portion. The elevation ranges from about 5400 to 6800 ft. above sea level. The soil is sandy clay, gravel and rocky. The vegetation consists of greasewood, rabbitbrush and native grass.

Principal users of the area are cattlemen. Access into the township is provided by numerous desert trail roads.

No mineral formations of consequence were noted during the survey.
