	<p style="text-align: center;">GENERAL DESCRIPTION</p> <p>The area resurveyed within Township 17 North, Range 25 East, varies from gently rolling to nearly level. The elevation is about 4200 ft. above sea level. The soil varies from sandy to sandy clay loam. The vegetation consists of greasewood and saltgrass.</p> <p>Principal users of the area are cattlemen and farmers, access into the township is provided by numerous trail roads throughout the area. No mining activity of consequence was noted during this survey.</p>
