- 3.27 The closing cor. of Tps. 34 and 35 N., R. 68 E., monumented with a limestone, 17x8x7 ins., firmly set in a mound of stone, mkd. with 6 grooves on N., S. and E. faces and CC on E. face.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., on solid rock over a cross (X) and in a mound of stone, 4 ft. base to top, with brass cap mkd.
