

SURVEY OF A PORTION OF THE SUBDIVISIONAL LINES,
T. 5 S., R. 55 E., MDM, NEVADA

CHAINS

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The lines surveyed within Township 5 South, Range 55 East, varies from rolling to mountainous land. The elevation ranges from about 5900 to 6200 ft. above sea level. The soil is sandy clay and rocky. The vegetation consists of sagebrush, greasewood and native grasses; there is scattered juniper and pinon on the higher elevations.

No mineral formations of consequence were noted during the survey.

Access into the township is provided by improved and unimproved desert trail roads throughout the township.
