GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The lines surveyed within Township 6 South, Range 55 East, is mountainous land. The elevation ranges from about 5400 to 6600 ft. above sea level. The soil is sandy clay and rocky. The vegetation consists of sagebrush, greasewood and native grasses; there is scattered juniper and pinon in the north portion of the township.

No mineral formations of consequence were noted during the survey.

Access into the township is provided by improved and unimproved desert trail roads throughout the township.
