square, with illegible scribe marks visible, wired to a
steel fence post, firmly set and exposed 4 ft. above the
ground.

At the corner point.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 22 ins. in
the ground, with brass cap mkd.
