OF T. 24 N., R. 41 E., MDM, NEVADA

## GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The land surveyed and resurveyed within Township 24 North, Range 41 East, is located in Antelope Valley and is gently rolling to rolling. The elevation ranges from about 5,000 to 5,700 feet above sea level. The township is drained by numerous dry washes.

The soil ranges from sandy clay loam and rocky in the higher elevation to sandy clay loam in the lower elevation. The vegetation consists of shadscale and white sage in the lower land to sagebrush and bunchgrass in the higher land.

Principal users of the area are cattlemen, and access into the township is provided by numerous desert roads. No mineral formations of consequence were noted during the survey.
