	GENERAL DESCRIPTION
	The area surveyed in sec. 4, T. 37 N., R. 62 E., is located within and adjacent to the city limits of the city of Wells, Nevada. The elevation varies from 5,600 to 5,800 ft. above sea level. The soil is sandy loam. The terrain is covered with sagebrush and open areas.
	No mineral formations of consequence were noted. The area is developed with subdivisional residences, with commercial district of Wells being mainly in the SE¼ of sec. 4.
	An average of a number of readings along the lines surveyed gives a mean magnetic declination of 17½° E., with a range of 2° caused by local attraction.
