	From the cor. of secs. 3, 4, 9 and 10. S. 89° 33' W., bet. secs. 4 and 9. Over rolling land, through medium sagebrush and bunchgrass.
12.50	Wash, 25 lks. wide, 2 ft. deep, drains SE.
39.56	Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 4 and 9, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner. Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd. <div>T38N R64E $\frac{1}{4}$ S 4 4 S 9</div> 1978 set a steel fence post, 6 ft. long, 22 ins. in the ground, alongside the iron post.
57.20	Fence, bears N. $1\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}$ E. and S. $1\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}$ W.
79.12	The cor. of secs. 4, 5, 8 and 9. <hr/>
	N. 1° 39' W., bet. secs. 4 and 5. Over rolling land, through medium sagebrush and bunchgrass.
41.50	Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 4 and 5, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner. Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd. <div>T38N R64E $\frac{1}{4}$ S 5 S 4</div> 1978 set a steel fence post, 6 ft. long, 22 ins. in the ground, alongside the iron post.
65.70	Trail road, bears E. and W.
82.22	The cor. of secs. 4, 5, 32 and 33, on the N. bdy. of the Tp. <hr/>
	From the cor. of secs. 5, 6, 31 and 32, on the S. bdy. of the Tp., monumented with an aluminum post, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., firmly set and exposed 8 ins. above the ground, with aluminum cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the dependent resurvey of T. 37 N., R. 64 E., executed under Group No. 533.
