	<p>From the cor. of Tps. 39 N., Rs. 64 and 65 E., determined latitudinally at record distance from the cor. of secs. 25, 30, 31 and 36, T. 39 N., Rs. 64 and 65 E., and longitudinally at proportionate measurement from the cor. of secs. 5, 6, 31, 31 and 32, Tps. 38, 38½ and 39 N., R. 65 E., and the S. ¼ sec. cor. of sec. 33, T. 39 N., R. 64 E.; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.</p> <p>Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">T39N R64E R65E <u>S 36 S 31</u> S 31 T38½N R65E</p> <p style="text-align: center;">1978</p> <p>raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, S. of cor.</p> <p>From this corner, the cor. of secs. 25, 30, 31 and 36, Tps. 39 N., Rs. 64 and 65 E., monumented with an iron post, 2½ ins. diam., firmly set and exposed 6 ins. above ground, mkd. as described in the field notes of the dependent resurvey of T. 39 N., R. 65 E., executed concurrently under this same group, bears N. 1° 09' W., 80.02 chs. dist.</p> <p>From this same corner, the cor. of secs. 5, 6, 31, 31 and 32, Tps. 38, 38½ and 39 N., R. 65 E., monumented with an iron post, 2½ ins. diam., firmly set and exposed 6 ins. above ground, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the dependent resurvey of T. 39 N., R. 65 E., executed concurrently under this same group, bears S. 89° 07' E., 52.62 chs. dist.</p> <p>N. 89° 52' W., along the S. bdy. of sec. 36.</p> <p>Over rolling land, through medium sagebrush and bunchgrass.</p>
