

SURVEY OF THE SUBDIVISIONAL LINES,
T. 38 $\frac{1}{2}$ N., R. 64 E., MDM, NEVADA

CHAINS

Point for the N. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 31, is determined NORTH of the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 6 and 31, Tps. 38 and 38 $\frac{1}{2}$ N., R. 64 E., and on the S. bdy. of sec. 31, T. 39 N., R. 64 E.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

From this corner, the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 31, T. 39 N., R. 64 E., bears S. 88° 46' E., 19.99 chs. dist.

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The land within Township 38 $\frac{1}{2}$ North, Range 64 East, ranges about 6,250 to 6,700 ft. above sea level, and is mostly rolling. The soil is sandy clay loam and rocky. The vegetation consists of sagebrush and bunchgrass. The township is drained by numerous dry washes draining SSE.

Principal users of the area are cattlemen and access into the township is provided by numerous trail roads throughout the area. No mineral formations of consequence were noted during the survey.
