N. 0° 45' W., bet. secs. 31 and 36.

Over gently rolling land, through scattered juniper, pinon, medium sagebrush and bunchgrass.

Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 31 and 36, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.
