The cor. of secs. 25, 30, 31 and 36, monumented with an iron pipe, 2 ins. diam., 36 ins. long, mkd. SECS. 25 and 36 T39N R64E on W. side and SECS. 30 and 31 T39N R65E on E. side, loosely set in a fence corner, from which fences bears N. and E. This point correlates well with other existing original corners found on the S. bdrs. of Tps. 39 N. Rs. 64 and 65 E. and is accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
