OF T. 10 N., R. 44 E., MDM, NEVADA

The E. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 20, monumented with an iron post, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., firmly set and exposed 6 ins. above the ground, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of T. 10 N., R. 44 E., executed under Group No. 527. Hereafter, the cor. will now refer to secs. 20 and 21. Remark the brass cap as follows:

From the SE. cor. of sec. 20, monumented with an iron post, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., firmly set and exposed 4 ins. above the ground, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of T. 10 N., R. 44 E., executed under Group No. 527. Hereafter, this corner will refer to secs. 20 and 29. Remark the brass cap as follows:

SOUTH, along the E. bdy. of sec. 29.

Over rolling land, through scattered undergrowth.

1.70 Trail road, bears ENE. and WSW.

2.40 Point for the cor. of secs. 21 and 28, determined at 40.00 chs. South in latitude, from the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 20 and 21, hereinbefore described.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

Raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, E. of cor.

No. 3 of M.S. 4429, Blue Jacket No. 1 lode, monumented with an iron post, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., firmly set and exposed 4 ins. above the ground, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of T. 10 N., R. 44 E., executed under Group No. 527, bears N. $48^{\circ} 23'$ E., 6.58 chs. dist.
