GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The land within Township 14 North, Range 43 East, ranges from about 5400 to 6300 ft. above sea level and varies from nearly level to rolling. The soil varies from sandy clay to sandy clay, gravelly and rocky. The vegetation consists of sagebrush, greasewood, buckbrush, rabbitbrush and shadscale.

The township drains in a southeasterly direction. The Smokey Valley Ranch house is situated in sec. 28 and the Triple T. Ranch house is located in sec. 10.

Principal users of the area are cattlemen. Access into the township is provided by Nevada State Highway No. 8A, which crosses the township in a northeasterly direction. There are numerous secondary and desert trail roads.

No mineral formations of consequence were noted during the resurvey.
