## CHAINS

Point for the W.  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of sec. 5, at 40.00 chs. in latitude from the cor. of secs. 5, 6, 7 and 8, and on the E. bdy. of sec. 6.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long,  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

set a steel fence post, 5 ft. long, 24 ins. in the ground, alongside the iron post.

From this corner, the E.  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of sec. 6, monumented with an iron post,  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam., hereinbefore described, bears N.  $0^{\circ} 24'$  E., 0.22 chs. dist.

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

Township 20 North, Range 43 East is situated about 6 miles NNW. of Austin, Nevada. The elevation varies from about 5500 to 6900 feet above sea level. The soil varies from silt along the river bottom to sandy clay and rocky in the higher elevations.

The vegetation consists of sagebrush, greasewood, shadscale, crestedwheat grass, with willows along the river.

The Reese River crosses the western portion of the township in a NNW. direction. Italian Creek drains WNW. through the center of the township into the Reese River. There is a ranch house in section 11.

Access into the township is provided by Nevada State Highway No. 8A, which crosses the township in a NNW. direction and other improved and unimproved roads.

Principal users of the area are cattlemen.

No mineral formations of consequence were noted during the survey.
