

DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF THE SUBDIVISIONAL LINES,
T. 38 N., R. 63 E., MDM, NEVADA

CHAINS	GENERAL DESCRIPTION
	<p>Township 38 North, Range 63 East is situated about 4 miles NNE. of Wells, Nevada. The elevation varies from about 5900 to 7700 ft. above sea level. The soil varies from sandy clay loam and rocky in the higher elevations to black loam on the bottom land. The vegetation consists of juniper, pinon, sagebrush and bunchgrass in the higher elevations and sagebrush, bunchgrass and meadowgrass in the bottom land. The abandoned Union Pacific Railroad bed and U.S. Highway No. 93 crosses the township in a northerly course in the W. portion of the Township. Further access into the area is provided by numerous desert trail roads.</p> <p>Principal users of the area are cattlemen. There was no mining activity of consequence noted during the survey.</p>
