

SURVEY OF TRACT 37,
TOWNSHIP 12 NORTH, RANGE 55½ EAST, MDM, NEVADA

CHAINS

The following field notes are those of the survey of Tract 37 in unsurveyed T. 12 N., R. 55½ E., Mount Diablo Meridian, Nevada.

The east boundary of T. 12 N., R. 55½ E. (Ruby Valley Guide Meridian), was surveyed by U.S. Deputy Surveyor E. B. Monroe in 1869 under Contract No. 25. The north 3 miles of the west boundary of T. 12 N., R. 56 E., (Ruby Valley Guide Meridian), was resurveyed by Cadastral Surveyor Terrence O. Nickerson in 1976 under Group No. 542.

The directions of the lines of this survey were determined by azimuth taken from U.S.C. & G.S. triangulation station "IRWIN". The lines were carried forward by sustained angulation throughout the progress of the survey.

The survey was executed in accordance with the specifications as set forth in the Manual of Surveying Instructions, 1973, and the Special Instructions dated September 27, 1978.

The geographic position of Angle Point No. 6, identical with the ¼ sec. cor. of sec. 18, T. 12 N., R. 56 E. is at latitude 38° 54' 08.2" N. and longitude 115° 43' 31.8" W., calculated along section lines from the cor. of secs. 19 and 30, T. 13 N., R. 56 E., which is a Tellurometer station established under Group No. 389.

The mean magnetic declination was found to be 16½° east.

SURVEY OF TRACT 37,
T. 12 N., R. 55½ E., MOUNT DIABLO MERIDIAN, NEVADA

Beginning at Angle Point No. 1, Tract 37, identical with the S. 1/16 sec. cor. of sec. 7, monumented with an iron post, 2½ ins. diam., exposed 3 ins. above the ground, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the dependent resurvey of a portion of the Ruby Valley Guide Meridian, T. 12 N., R. 56 E., resurveyed under Group No. 542.

Remark the iron post to read as follows:
