

TOWNSHIP 22 NORTH, RANGE 64 EAST, MDM, NEVADA

CHAINS

The following field notes are those of the dependent resurvey between sections 4 and 9 of Township 22 North, Range 64 East, Mount Diablo Meridian, Nevada.

The boundaries and subdivisional lines were surveyed by U.S. Deputy Surveyor E.B. Monroe in 1875, under Contract No. 70. The east boundary was resurveyed by U.S. Cadastral Engineer Carl S. Swanholm and U.S. Transitman Edie S.C. Smith in 1924, under Group No. 102. The west boundary was resurveyed by Cadastral Surveyor Horace G. Parker in 1963, under Group No. 413. The south boundary was resurveyed by Cadastral Surveyors Horace G. Parker and Robert A. Pratt in 1966, under Group No. 440.

Before restoring the corners, the line of the original survey was retraced and diligent search made for any evidence of the original corners and other calls of the original field note record.

After completing the necessary retracements, the original monuments or local evidence was accepted to ascertain the position of all corners. In order to simplify the record, the true line notes only are supplied herewith which refer to the completed resurvey.

The directions of the lines of this resurvey were determined by altitude observations of the sun.

The survey was executed in accordance with the specifications as set forth in the Manual of Surveying Instructions, 1973, and the Special Instructions dated September 27, 1978.

The geographic position of the cor. of sections 3, 4, 9 and 10, is at latitude $39^{\circ} 47.8' N.$ and longitude $114^{\circ} 44.0' W.$, based on positions shown on Nevada Projection Diagram No. 306 and calculated through record surveys.

The mean magnetic declination is $17\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ east.
