CHAINS

- 40.11 Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 2, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.
- Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

- Raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, W. of cor.
- 80.59 The closing cor. of secs. 1 and 2, monumented with the decayed remains of a wooden post, 2 ins. square, 16 ins. long, loosely set in a mound of earth. No scribe marks visible.
- At the corner point
- Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

- Reset the decayed remains of the original wooden post alongside the iron post and raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, S. of cor.
- From this corner, the standard cor. of secs. 35 and 36, T. 11 N., R. 46 E., monumented with an iron post, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., firmly set showing 6 ins. above ground, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the dependent resurvey of T. 11 N., R. 46 E., executed concurrently under this same group, bears S. $88^{\circ} 51' E.$, 11.40 chs. dist.

- Point for the N. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 1 is at midpoint bet. the closing cors. and on the S. bdy. of sec. 36, T. 11 N., R. 46 E.
- Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
