

DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF A PORTION  
OF THE SUBDIVISIONAL LINES,  
T. 11 N., R. 47 E., MDM, NEVADA

The cor. of secs. 5, 6, 31 and 32, on the N. bdy. of the Tp., monumented with an iron post,  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam., firmly set and showing 4 ins. above the ground, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the dependent resurvey of T. 12 N., R. 47 E., executed concurrently under this same group.

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The land resurveyed within Township 11 North, Range 47 East, ranges from about 6800 to 7200 ft. above sea level, and is nearly level to gently rolling. The soil is sandy clay and rocky. The vegetation consists of sagebrush, rabbitbrush and greasewood, with willows along the creeks.

The township is drained by Mosquito Creek, which flows northwesterly through the center of the township.

Principal users of the area are cattlemen and access into the township is provided by improved and unimproved desert trail roads.

No mineral formations of consequence were noted during the survey.
