CHAINS

from this corner

The chimney of a ranch house, bears N. $26\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E.,
45.58 chs. dist.

N. $89^{\circ} 03'$ W., bet. secs. 6 and 31.

Over nearly level land, through scattered rabbitbrush
and greasewood.

23.50 Bladed road, bears NE. and SW.

39.14 The original $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 6 and 31, monumented
with a granite stone, 12x10x8 ins., firmly set 6 ins. in
the ground, plainly mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ on N. face.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 24 ins.
in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, N. of cor.

Over nearly level land.

40.27 The cor. of Tps. 11 and 12 N., Rs. 46 and 47 E.,
monumented with an iron post, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., firmly set
and exposed 4 ins. above the ground, with brass cap mkd.
as described in the field notes of the dependent
resurvey of T. 12 N., R. 46 E., executed concurrently
under this same group.

Reestablishment of the Survey Executed by
D.H. Barker, U.S. Deputy Surveyor,
in 1874.

From the original cor. of Tps. 12 and 13 N., Rs. 47 and
48 E., monumented with a granite stone, 20x12x10 ins.,
firmly set 10 ins. in the ground, plainly mkd. with 6
notches on the N., S., E. and W. edges. Hereafter this
corner will refer to the cor. of T. 13 N., R. 47 E.,
only.
