## GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The land resurveyed within Township 12 North, Range 47 East, ranges from about 6700 to 7200 ft. above sea level, and is nearly level to rolling. The soil varies from sandy clay to gravelly and rocky. The vegetation consists of sagebrush, rabbitbrush, greasewood, shadscale and whitesage.

There are scattered juniper and pinon in the higher elevations of little commercial value.

The township is drained by numerous dry washes draining westerly through the township.

Principal users of the area are cattlemen and access into the township is provided by numerous improved and unimproved desert trail roads.

No mineral formations of consequence were noted during the resurvey.
