This iron post was rusted off at ground level, with a 12 in. piece lying alongside, mkd. as described in the field notes of the dependent resurvey of the S. bdy. of T. 30 N., R. 48 E., executed under Group No. 25.</p> <p>At the corner point</p> <p>Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, in a fence bearing E. and W., with brass cap mkd.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"> <u>$\frac{1}{4}$ S 5</u> <u>T29N R48E</u> 1978 </p> <p>bury the original corner alongside the iron post.</p> <hr style="width: 20%; margin: auto;"/> <p>S. $89^{\circ} 07'$ W., beginning new measurement.</p> <p>Over nearly level land, along fence.</p>

40.02	<p>The cor. of secs. 5 and 6, monumented with an iron post, 3 ins. diam., firmly set and exposed 12 ins. above the ground, mkd. as described in the field notes of the dependent resurvey of the S. bdy. of T. 30 N., R. 48 E., executed under Group No. 25. This corner is located at a fence cor., from which fences bear S. and E.</p> <hr style="width: 60%; margin: auto;"/> <p>S. $89^{\circ} 07'$ W., along the N. bdy. of sec. 6.</p> <p>Over nearly level land, through sagebrush.</p>
